

## *Membership Types*

### ***Full Membership***

#### *Eligibility for Full Membership*

A HBMA member should be a registered midwife:

- A. of Greek nationality who lives, works or studies in the UK, regardless where the Midwifery Bachelor Degree was obtained;
- B. of any nationality who has studied midwifery in a Higher Education Institute in Greece and lives, works or studies in the UK;
- C. or in case of Cypriot midwife who has not studied in Greece, but lives, works or studies in the UK, it is up to the discretion of the HBMA board to apply successfully for the full membership.

The full membership has no registration fee and the annual membership fee is 25£.

These members have:

- Networking opportunities
- Free access to events and conferences or at a discounted rate when there is a fee
- Access and use of all the electronic platforms of the organisation, for purposes relevant to the ethos and the activity of the HBMA (when available)
- Opportunity to participate actively in the formation and the tasks of the organisation
- One to one 45 minutes coaching session

### ***Fellow Membership***

Fellow members can be midwives who are not eligible for the full membership, ie. midwives who haven't completed their registration with the NMC yet, allied healthcare professionals and others who wish to be informed about the activities of the organisation.

The Fellow Members will have no registration fee and annual fee 35£.

These members have:

- One to one 45 minutes coaching session
- Free access to events and conferences or at a discounted rate when there is a fee

### ***Honorary Membership***

Honorary Member to be a healthcare or other professional who wishes to positively contribute towards achieving the aims and the objectives of the organisation. These professionals might be experts in their field.

The Honorary Members would have no registration and no annual fees.

Membership rights will be considered and reviewed by the board, based on the status and the contribution of the honorary member. Someone who applies for full membership has the right to propose to the board for honorary members.
