Are you interested in a different clinical pathway from Midwifery? Do you have passion for Fetal Medicine Research and ultrasounds? If yes, then this is something you need to know about.

The Fetal Medicine Foundation is a Registered Charity that aims to improve the health of pregnant women and their babies through research and training in fetal medicine.

The Foundation, with the support of an international group of experts, has introduced an educational programme, both for healthcare professionals and parents, and a series of certificates of competence in different aspects of fetal medicine.

After you register with the Fetal Medicine Foundation, you need to undertake internet-based online courses which are free and available in 13 languages, such as:

- Fetal Abnormalities
- Screening for Preeclampsia
- The 11 to 13 weeks scan
- Cervical Assessment
- Fetal Echocardiography
- Doppler Ultrasound

Applicants should then complete the [FMF Fellowship Form](#); send it together with a reference from their Head of the Department to the FMF email address education@fetalmedicine.org.

It is important that before you apply you have completed all internet based theoretical courses.
